Curriculum Delivery

Rationale

1. The school will:

 - Monitor student progress against the national achievement objectives and the National Standards
 - Assess student achievement, maintain individual records and report on student progress.
2. The school will have written implementation plans for each curriculum area that clearly outline procedures for presenting that curriculum. These plans are reviewed in accordance with the schools self review programme.
