



Students pave the way in Greytown

Greytown School's Kaitiaki Crew Envirogroup were busy preparing a report earlier this year for the South Wairarapa District Council.

In the report the Kaitiaki Crew recommend streets that need new footpaths and other improvements to help students walk to school safely.

The students used parents' comments about footpaths from their Travel Plan Survey, and mapped

where students lived, to help them prioritise streets. They also took a field trip to photograph the streets that required new footpaths.

The report is part of a wider project being undertaken by students at Kuranui College in conjunction with the Wairarapa Workforce Development Trust's Education for Enterprise.
