We appreciate your patience waiting for details of the Greytown School Fun Run. Barton’s Farm, the usual site for the Cross Country, was not available to us this year due to timing of the return to school in Term 2.

This will not be a whole day event and children are expected to attend school as normal in the morning.

We are fortunate that ‘The Orchards’ and Holmes Construction have opened up their site location to Greytown School to have the ‘Fun Run’ there this year. We will be running around areas where they are not currently working and their site construction area will be clearly marked off.
