COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS

With a growing school, we would like to take this opportunity to remind parents and families about common communication systems in our school. It is important that you are able to keep fully up to date and informed with upcoming events etc

- School Newsletters these come out once a fortnight (starting the first week of the school term). These come out via our school app, school website, email (if you let the office know) or we can print them out in hardcopy (also if you let the office know). They contain dates and important information for upcoming events so you can be organised and get involved.
- School App This is a one-stop-shop for communication and is an essential way of staying in touch with daily activities. You can download this free app called "Kiwi Schools Connect", select our school and then you will receive all the alerts, changes, newsletters etc. You can also send in daily absences on this too!
- **Greytown Primary Facebook** This is another way we try to keep our parents in touch with upcoming events as well as share photos of celebrations, activities and community activities that our families like to get involved in.

- School Office If you have questions or need further clarification after reading the above sources of information then you can either email our office team <u>office@greytown.school.nz</u>, pop in or ring them directly.
- **Class Systems** Our class teachers will be able to help you get set up with the right system for your class eg: Seesaw, Emails, Google Classroom. From here teachers will share wonderful learning with you that your child has done and also send out notices etc that relate directly to your child. SCHOOL DONATIONS AND YEAR 7 & 8 costs

Thank you to all the parents who have already paid the school donation and the costs for their Yr7/8 child.

Normally we request the school donation in term 2 but this year we delayed this. These donations make a huge difference in our ability to provide additional learning opportunities and support for our children. For 1 child it is \$100, for 2 children it is \$130 and for 3 or more it is \$150. Remember you can claim $\frac{1}{3}$ of this back as a tax rebate.

For the Year 7 & 8 children the costs are: \$50 for technology at Kuranui to cover the cost of materials, \$25 per term for EOTC and \$125 for camp for a year 7 and \$170 for camp for year 8. You can pay in instalments or a lump sum. Please check with Carol in the office if you need to confirm the balance owing.

FINALLY

Good luck to all 60 kids who are taking part today in the first Interschool Competition and "have a go day" for Football. It is great to see our kids being able to get together across the South Wairarapa (since COVID).


Rail safety week 10-16 August - Cross with Care | Kia tūpato te whakawhiti

Rail Safety Week aims to reduce near miss collisions on level crossings. Every near miss is a traumatic event and has a very real impact on the locomotive engineers, the witnesses involved and on those who nearly lost their lives. Never cross when bells or lights are activated and always look carefully in both directions before crossing. Be especially careful to look for a second train. If one train has stopped at a station another one could be coming.
