



Dear Parents / Whānau,

Pet day is one of our big highlights on the School calendar that everyone looks forward to. Unfortunately under current restrictions of Level 2 we can only have 100 people at a gathering. Therefore, this means that we will not be able to run pet day the way we have in the past.
