- There will be no children on the school site during the day as we will all be at Barton's farm.

# ❖ CHILDREN GOING TO AND FROM IN PRIVATE CARS/SIGN OUT

- ➤ Please inform the School whether your child is going straight out to the farm so we can account for them on our role.
- ➤ Please let your classroom teacher know by Monday 15th May if your child/ren is traveling in a private car.
- ➤ At the end of the day If your child is not going back on the school buses you need to **sign out your child** on the sign out board at the event unless you have already arranged this with their class teacher.
- ➤ If you are wanting other family members or friends' parents to take your child/ren home in their cars **please notify your class teacher before the event** (le: See them, email or send a note with your child.)
