WAIRARAPA ROAD SAFETY COUNCIL

We work with the school to promote and educate around road safety, in particular ensuring that all children have a safe passage getting to and from school. We understand that with the on-going works happening in Reading Street that there is increased traffic using East Street. With this, it is really important that we each play our part to make sure that we do what we can to mitigate anything that could cause an unwanted 'incident'.

We ask of you to take care when approaching the school and contribute to a positive road safety culture outside of the school by doing the following:

· Please avoid impeding visibility at the pedestrian crossing.

- · Do not park on yellow line near the crossing
- · Obey road patrollers signals and signs
- All parents and children walk on the footpath to the pedestrian crossing so that no one is obscured by parked vehicles.
- Park further down the road and encourage your child to walk the rest of the way to school (or walk with them).
- If you have to drop a child off closer to the school where it is appropriate to do so, please do not leave your vehicle as some areas are only designated as a 'kiss and drop' location. To find out where those spots are, please talk to the school office.
