Last Thursday saw Greytown school enter 5 teams into Matharapa, a region wide maths competition where students work as a team in three rounds to win the trophy.



The biannual Artsplash Event was held in Wellington, running for the duration of the week. Greytown sent two groups of students to perform in shows during this Arts Festival. Both groups travelled over by train at 7:20am and spent the day at rehearsals, touring Te Papa and participating in workshops. They also managed to have some time at Te Aro Park around these activities. The choir performed on Monday evening in the Michael Fowler Centre in a mass choir of 400 students to an audience of over 1000 and accompanied by the Wellington Symphony Orchestra. It was a fantastic opportunity and our students really shone on the night. Their enjoyment and enthusiasm was evident on stage and their behaviour was exemplary.

The Choir were lucky enough to secure a place in a workshop with the Wellington symphony orchestra conductor and as a result later performed their sound scape percussion piece on the Michael Fowler Centre Stage. We also had two soloists Lucia Opie and Lara Christ join a small group of students from other schools to perform a 'solo.' As we were seated centre stage, Greytown was a stand out throughout the performance this year.
